## Glossary of Z'manim

Wk	Week Number of the Hebrew year.
Date	Date according to the Gregorian Calendar.
AlotH	Alot ha-Shachar is the time when the sun is 16.1 degrees below the horizon before sunrise, the earliest time to begin Shacharit.
Talit	Talit u-Tefilin is the time when the sun is 11 degrees below the horizon before sunrise, the earliest time to put on Talit and Tefilin.
SunRs	Sunrise, known in Hebrew as Zerichat ha-Chama or Zericha.
SZmKS	Sof Z'man Kriat Sh'ma is 3 proportional daylight hours after sunrise, the latest time to recite the morning Sh'ma. The Shitta given here is according to the GR"A (Vilna Gaon).
MdDay	Midday is the midpoint between sunrise and sunset, known in Hebrew as Chatzi Yom.
MinGd	Mincha G'dola is the earliest time to begin Mincha, 0.5 proportional daylight hours after midday.
MinKt	Mincha K'tana is the preferred earliest time to begin Mincha, 3.5 proportional daylight hours after midday.
Candl	Candle-Lighting Time is Z'man Hadlakat Nerot, 18 minutes before sunset.
SunSt	Sunset, known in Hebrew as Shkiyat ha-Chama or Shkiya.
3Med*	3 Medium Stars or Kochavim Bayn-onim marks the end of a Rabbinic public fast day, the time when the sun goes 7.5 degrees below the horizon. This is Tzeit ha-Kochavim d'Rabbanan.
3Sml*	3 Small Stars or Kochavim K'tanim marks the end of Shabbat or Yom Tov, the time when the sun goes 8.75 degrees below the horizon. This is Tzeit ha-Kochavim d'Oraita. (See Shabbat 34b,35a for definition of Tzeit ha-Kochavim).

Note: All times are given according to the 24-hour clock:  
1:00 = 1:00 AM, 13:00 = 1:00 PM.
